**Golf Cart Drivers**—Drivers of golf carts need to carry their driver's license or a copy of their license with them. You may obtain a copy of your driver's license at the Oceanside Village office. Golf carts are not allowed on the roads in the Village between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. and **rental golf carts cannot be taken off property** except to the beachfront parking lot. **Homeowner golf carts may be driven on secondary roads** up to four miles from residence as long as they have a South Carolina state sticker, during daylight hours. A fine could be imposed if these rules are not followed.

**Reminder**—Please remember that all landscaping must be two feet from the street. This is a safety issue. For some of the homes this is grandfathered in; however, as sales are made this will be corrected. This also applies to one rail fencing as approved by the Building and Grounds Committee.
