**House Numbers**—A reminder to all our homeowners regarding house numbers, every home in the village must have a house number prominently displayed. This is a requirement of 911 emergency. The numbers should be between 4 and 6 inches and of a contrasting color from the house.

**2018 Town Meeting**—The annual Oceanside Village town meeting is scheduled for **Saturday, October 13th at 10:00 a.m.** in the community center. All homeowners are invited. There will be door prizes and refreshments. Please come and support your community.

**Volunteers**—We would like to thank all of our volunteers who have helped out this summer. The staff at the Oceanside Village office appreciate everything they've done as well as all the hard work and time they have given us.

**Stairs and Decks**—Stairs and decks should be inspected annually for exposed nails, deteriorating boards, etc. A bonded contractor should be contacted to make these repairs. Nails that attach the deck to the house may appear fine, but can be weakened by rust between the deck and house. It is recommended to lag bolt the deck to the house.

**Beach Re-nourishment**—The beach re-nourishment project has begun in Surfside Beach going toward Myrtle Beach State Park with 500 feet of material being pumped in per day. There will be walk through areas provided between the pipes and beachgoers are asked not to walk on the pipes. The project will last about 30 days. After the section from State Park to Surfside Beach is complete, the southern portion of the beach re-nourishment will begin from the pier into Garden City Beach. The southern project is also scheduled to last approximately 30 days. Please be patient and considerate as the work progresses.
