## **Fox Family**

As some of you may know, we have a fox family temporarily residing in Oceanside Village. This is in all likelihood due to the development taking place across the street and forcing these animals to find other places to live. Miriam Gaskins has been in touch with the Department of Natural Resources and they indicate that babies must be a few months of age before they can be relocated or they will not survive. When the foxes are old enough, we can assure you, Management will make the necessary arrangements and have them moved to a rural location, which has been provided by the owner of a farm property. If they become too much of a nuisance during their growth period, we will be forced to remove these animals, which could be detrimental to their survival. Let's try to act humanely and not harm these foxes, however it would be helpful for homeowners to keep us informed of their specific location. The foxes should not be of any harm to our homeowner or their pets however, please do not try to pet them or treat them like a domestic animal.
