**Passes for 2023**—The packet containing the information and forms for your 2023 passes was mailed out recently. **We will be issuing passes in the management office beginning January 9, 2023.** You may also apply for your new passes through the mail or drop the forms by the office. Mail your forms to the same address as your lease and amenities payments. We will mail your passes back to you or hold them at the Oceanside Village office to be picked up. **Be sure to include all of your completed forms, copies of car registrations, proof of golf cart insurance, as well as monies due. All fees due to Oceanside Village, LLC and Oceanside Village must be current. You must fill out the pertinent information and next of kin form before any new passes can be issued. Also, the OSV permission form to add your name to the OSV directory must be filled out and returned.**

**Fitness Center Renewals**—Fitness center renewals will begin on **January 2, 2023.** **Homeowners** may come to the **Oceanside Village office from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday** to renew their ID badges. For new members there is a \$20.00 charge for the use of the fitness center and a \$5.00 charge for the entry card.
